
Marbella, Estepona, Mijas, Benalmádena, and Fuengirola

The "Golden Triangle", Marbella, Estepona, and Benahavís, has solidified its status as a prime luxury real estate zone. In 2024, these areas collectively sold 8,708 luxury homes, marking a 5.64% increase from the previous year. Marbella led with 4,745 sales, followed by Estepona (3,162) and Benahavís (801).

Marbella's property prices have surged, with some areas exceeding €5,000 per square meter. Estepona is experiencing a development boom, boasting over 127 new residential projects, including the notable Sunset Plazamar Residencial. Mijas continues

to attract buyers seeking a blend of coastal charm and affordability, with prices averaging between €3,970 and €4,110 /m² depending on property type. Benalmádena is seeing similar momentum, with average property prices reaching around €3,079 /m² in 2024, up 15.1% from the previous year. Neighbouring Fuengirola sits slightly higher at €3,249 /m², reflecting an 11.3% annual rise.

Rental prices on the Costa del Sol have increased by 8.9%, driven by a surge in tourist demand and a significant rise in tourist properties since 2019. This trend has led many property owners to favour short-term rentals over long-term leases, impacting residents' access to affordable housing. The buyer demographic is diversifying, with increased interest from Eastern European nationals, particularly from Ukraine, Poland, and Lithuania. Additionally, U.S. investors are flocking to the region, attracted by luxury beachfront properties and the area's lifestyle offerings.

The Costa del Sol continues to draw a growing number of residents, not just tourists, thanks to its year-round sunshine, improved

international flight connections, and laid-back yet dynamic lifestyle. 

Foreign Residents Now Make Up Nearly a Quarter of Málaga Province

The province of Málaga continues to attract international residents in large numbers, with new figures from Spain's National Statistics Institute (INE) revealing that 23% of its population is now foreign-born. That's 414,316 people out of a total 1.77 million residents—well above the national average of 18%.

Residents born abroad

Among the 103 municipalities in the province, 35 have foreign populations exceeding 20%. Benahavís ranks highest, with around 64% of residents born abroad, including a large community of British, Russian and Latin American nationals. Fuengirola, Manilva and Torrox follow closely behind, with over 40% of their residents hailing from other countries. In Fuengirola alone, more than 38,000 of the 85,600 residents are foreign-born.

Marbella, Mijas and Benalmádena each have around 37% foreign residents. Marbella has the largest foreign-born population in absolute numbers, with nearly 61,000 non-Spanish residents—primarily from Morocco, Latin America and the UK. These areas remain popular among retirees, second-home

owners, and digital nomads drawn by climate, lifestyle and connectivity.

International region

Málaga city registers a slightly lower percentage at just under 16%, but still houses more than 93,000 foreign-born people. Most are from Latin America, followed by European and Moroccan communities. Alhaurín de la Torre and Vélez-Málaga have similar levels.

Inland towns remain less internationally populated, with municipalities like Cañete la Real and Teba seeing foreign populations below 5%. Nevertheless, the trend is clear: the Costa del Sol is becoming one of Europe's most international regions—not only as a holiday destination, but also as a thriving place to live and invest.






